There are 700 islands of The Bahamas sprinkled over 100,000 square miles of ocean starting at just 50 miles off the coast of Florida. The archipelago is an ecological oasis that boasts the clearest water on the planet, with a visibility extending over 200 feet! You can see your toes as easily as you can see the world's third largest barrier reef!

We invite you to explore all of our islands, each with their individual beauty; the only constants are the crystal clear waters and smiles on the faces of

the Bahamian people. The sounds of our music and culture along with the true hospitality of our country and our colorful history make the islands of The Bahamas an incredible destination.

TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS FOR ENTERING THE BAHAMAS

To assist with preventing the spread of COVID-19 and reduce the risk of exposure, registered guests will need to follow these government protocols:

1. Effective August 6, 2021, international visitors traveling to The Bahamas from other countries who are fully vaccinated will be required to obtain a COVID-19 test (Rapid Antigen Test or PCR), with a negative result, within five days of arrival in The Bahamas..
2. All vaccinated and unvaccinated individuals must apply for the Bahamas Travel Health Visa no more than five (5) days prior to their arrival date in The Bahamas and opt-in to COVID-19 health insurance; the COVID-19 health insurance covers travelers for the duration of their stay in The Bahamas. The cost of insurance is included in the Bahamas Travel Health Visa application fee.

The Travel Health Visa cost is dependent on the length of stay.

- \$40 per person for a 4-night, five-day stay
- \$60 per person for more than a four-night stay.
- Children 11 years of age and under are free
- The fee includes mandatory health insurance.

3. All unvaccinated or not fully vaccinated individuals visiting The Bahamas must obtain a negative COVID-19 RT-PCR (swab) test taken no more than five days prior to their arrival date in The Bahamas. Children, between the ages of 2 and 11 are required to obtain a COVID-19 test (Rapid Antigen Test or PCR), with a negative result, within five days of arrival in The Bahamas. Children, under the age of 2, are exempt from any testing requirements. All travelers, entering The Bahamas on a cruise ship, will be subjected to the testing requirements mandated by the cruise line and approved by the Competent Authority.

- a. Once a negative COVID-19 RT-PCR (swab) test is obtained, travelers can apply for their required Bahamas Travel Health Visa at travel.gov.bs.
- b. To learn more about The Bahamas Travel Health Visa and health insurance, visit atlantisbahamas.com/travel-updates.
- c. Please print copies of the following for each traveler:
 - Negative COVID-19 test results
 - Approved Health Travel Visa with Q.R. code visible
 - Receipt for payment of the Travel Health Visa

4. Unvaccinated visitors that stay longer than four nights must take the Bahamas government-mandated Rapid Antigen test on Day 5 of their stay.

5. Fully vaccinated visitors will not be required to take a Rapid Antigen test on Day 5 of their stay.
6. Travelers 18 years of age and older must complete an individual Bahamas Travel Health Visa.
7. Travelers 17 years of age and younger should add a profile within the account of their parent or guardian.
8. Bahamas Travel Health Visa applications take up to 48 hours to process and should be completed with adequate lead time.

For individuals returning to the United States, Atlantis will provide a total of two free Rapid Antigen Tests per room for registered guests of The Royal, The Cove, The Reef and The Coral hotels. A minimum night stay is not required. Testing excludes Harborside Resort reservations, Reef Owner reservations and Reef Owner guests, Marriott Bonvoy Redemption reservations, Marriott Associate reservations, and Caesar Gold Casino reservations.

There are no changes to the current U.S. travel policy for all individuals to present a negative test result within three days of re-entry to the U.S. These requirements still apply to everyone vaccinated or not.

CDC US RE-ENTRY TRAVEL REQUIREMENTS

Effective January 26, 2021, U.S citizens and international travelers ages 2 years of age and older returning to the United States are required to present a negative Rapid Antigen or COVID-19 RT-PCR test.

The negative COVID-19 test must be taken within three days (72 hours) of departure and presented pre-departure at the airport. Airlines must deny passengers boarding if they do not provide a negative COVID-19 test result or show proof of a recent positive viral test.

Visitors returning to the United States may use the Day 5 Bahamas government-mandated Rapid Antigen negative test result to re-enter the U.S. as long as their departure date is on the 6th, 7th, or 8th day of their stay and test results are negative.

*Atlantis will provide a total of two free Rapid Antigen Tests per room for registered guests of The Royal, The Cove, The Reef and The Coral hotels. A minimum night stay is not required. Testing excludes Harborside Resort reservations, Reef Owner reservations and their guests, Marriott Bonvoy Redemption reservations, Marriott Associate reservations, and Caesar Gold Casino reservations.

Rapid Antigen test cost: \$20 (two free Rapid Antigen Tests per room for registered guests return travel to the United States)
RT-PCR test cost: \$165

COVID-19 ON-PROPERTY PROTOCOLS

Should a guest test positive for COVID-19, the individual will be notified immediately and re-tested with the RT-PCR test. Atlantis will contact both the Bahamas Ministry of Health and its Safety Council to ensure the appropriate contact tracing and safety protocols are implemented immediately.

While waiting for results, guests will be required to quarantine at the hotel in their guestroom. The Bahamas Travel Health Visa and accompanying medical insurance is available to cover medical expenses related to COVID-19.

It is important to note that due to the fluidity of the COVID-19 pandemic, both in The Bahamas and worldwide, the safety protocols and procedures are subject to change.

PASSPORT REQUIREMENTS

If you are a U.S. Citizen, the Islands of The Bahamas follow the U.S. Government international travel requirements for re-entry into the U.S., thus you will need a valid U.S. Passport. If you do not have a passport, please visit www.travel.state.gov for the most current information about the passport application process. Please ensure ample time to apply as passports can take a few months for processing.

USEFUL INFORMATION

Language: English is the national language of The Bahamas and is infused with a local Bahamian dialect.

Currency: The legal tender is the Bahamian dollar, which is the exact equivalent in value to the U.S. dollar. Both the Bahamian dollar and the U.S. dollar are accepted throughout The Bahamas, as are most major credit cards and travelers checks.

Time Zone: Eastern Standard Time (EST) is used on all islands. From the second Sunday in March until the first Sunday in November, The Bahamas recognizes Daylight Savings time in conjunction with the United States.

Banking hours: Monday through Thursday, 9:30 a.m. to 3 p.m., Friday, 9:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Automatic Banking Machines (ATMs) are located in most major banks on both Nassau/ Paradise Island.

Cell Phones: Mobile phone service is available on Paradise Island via most providers, however roaming charges are costly. Please check with your provider for roaming charges.

Electricity Adapters: The Bahamas uses a voltage capacity of 110V, equivalent to North American voltage standards.

Drinking Water: Faucet water in Nassau/Paradise Island is safe to drink.

Gratuities: Restaurants and hotels automatically add 15% to all food and beverage checks. Additional tipping is optional.

Value Added Tax: The 12% VAT will be charged on all goods and services supplied in The Bahamas.

AIRPORTS

Lynden Pindling International Airport (LPIA) is the largest airport in The Bahamas, and the largest international gateway into The Bahamas. LPIA is located 10 miles (16km) west of the capital city of Nassau. The airport contains U.S. Border preclearance facilities allowing all US flights to operate as domestic flights upon arrival within the United States.

Independent fixed-based operator (FBO) brands are available in The Bahamas. Services range from arranging landing permits to aircraft greeting and escorting passengers through Customs and Immigration. This airport is adjacent to LPIA.

WEATHER

Thanks to the warm Gulf Stream currents and balmy trade winds, The Islands of The Bahamas are blessed with a sub-tropical climate. Water temperatures range from the low 80s in the summer to about 74°F in the midwinter.

The weather historically experienced in November is typically warm, but as it is a transitional time between our wet and dry seasons, we suggest loose airy clothing for daytime wear, and a light sweater or jacket for the evenings. November also marks the end of the official hurricane season.

Average temperatures in the month of November range from a high of 82° F to a low of 71° F and brief heavy showers are common throughout the year - our Liquid Sunshine!

travel & lodging

As The Bahamas are not part of the United States, you must possess a valid passport. Before you arrive in Nassau, Immigration cards will be distributed to everyone to fill out prior to landing and you will present this card to Immigration before collecting your luggage. Once you clear Immigration, proceed to baggage claim where you can collect your luggage. Please note that porters are available to assist with luggage if needed.

Once you have collected your luggage, keep your passport in hand and proceed to the Tourist queue at the Customs checkpoint. Be prepared to undergo a luggage search if asked by the Customs Officer. After clearing Customs, you'll be met by an Atlantis Representative who will direct you to your transportation to the Resort. Atlantis is located 16 miles from the International Airport. The ride is approximately 30 minutes.

ACCOMMODATIONS

The resort consists of five hotels: The Beach, The Coral, The Royal, The Cove and The Reef. There is a separate lobby for each hotel, and your ground transportation will drop you off accordingly. Any guests staying at The Beach will be brought to The Coral Lobby for check-in. Assistance with luggage will be provided by bell services. Please ensure that all luggage is tagged with the name and contact information of each guest to help this process run smoothly.

All guests are required to sign a resort registration card upon check in which lists the hotel's terms and conditions. For more information, please visit our website, www.atlantisbahamas.com.

AGE RESTRICTIONS

While Atlantis offers a world of fun for all ages, there are a few age regulations which are strictly enforced.

The minimum age requirements are as follows:

- To reserve a room - 18 years of age or older**
- To drink alcohol and/or gamble - 18 years of age or older

**Please note that one person staying in each room must be at least 18 years old or above to confirm a room in any of the hotels of Atlantis. This guest must hold a major credit card in his or her own name to be used at check-in.

ROOM AMENITIES/WI-FI

Each room is equipped with a TV, coffee maker, iron and ironing board, hair dryer and in-room safe for the storage of valuables. All rooms are equipped with a mini refrigerator. TEAM AIRPORT TRANSPORTATION

Each travel party will be responsible for their transportation to and from the airport. Teams will depart the Resort three hours before flight departure time. AWARDS

An awards ceremony will immediately follow the completion of the Championship Game. The Bad Boy Mowers Women's Battle 4 Atlantis trophy, shirts, and hats will be presented to the Champions and the Most Valuable Player will be announced. A trophy will also be presented to the runner-up. A five (5) member All-Tournament Team (which includes the Most Valuable Player) will also be announced at the end of the Championship Game.

BENCH DESIGNATION

During each game, the Home bench will be to the left side of the scorer's table as one faces it from mid-court. The teams will warm up away from their respective benches prior to the start of the game.

CHEER, DANCE TEAM, BAND AND MASCOT POLICIES

Each school's uniformed cheer and dance teams and pep band will be admitted to the team's games at no charge. All cheer, dance teams and band groups are welcome to attend the Tournament and should coordinate their own travel arrangements through 1-800-Atlantis. Bands will be seated in a designated area of the end zone sections when their team is playing, based on seat availability.

Cheerleaders, dance teams and the costumed mascots will be escorted to the arena floor by a tournament representative and placed in a designated area in the end zone sections based on seating availability when their team is playing.

COACHES SCOUTING SEATS

During the first and second days of the Tournament, two coaches' scouting seats will be provided only for coaches of teams that could play the teams of the game in progress in the next round. There will be no scouting seats available for the final day of the Tournament. This will be strictly enforced.

COACHES ATTIRE

Coaches and staff are encouraged to dress in resort casual attire for each of the Bad Boy Mowers Women's Battle 4 Atlantis games. There will not be any mandated attire during the Tournament, so please feel free to wear what is most appropriate.

COURT ACCESS

Teams participating in the first game of each day will have access to the Imperial Arena court one hour prior to tip-off. Teams in all proceeding games will have access to the court a minimum of 20 minutes prior to tip-off.

CREDENTIALS

Teams will receive their Official Travel Party credentials from their Team Host upon arrival to the Resort.

Media credentials will be available for pick-up beginning on Saturday, November 20, 2021, at 9 a.m. from the Credential Room located at the entrance to the Sports Facility. Credentials are required at all times for entrance to the Sports Facility and will be required on Practice Day and throughout the three days of the Tournament. GAME BALLS

Nike Elite basketballs are the official basketball for Bad Boy Mowers Women's Battle 4 Atlantis. Basketballs will be available on the arena floor before each game and at halftime. Basketballs are to remain on the playing court during team warm-ups and are not permitted in locker rooms. A game ball will be selected by Game Officials prior to each game.

At the conclusion of Tournament, all game balls will be donated to a local school's sports program.

GAME MANAGEMENT

Game Management will be administered by the Atlantic Coast Conference (ACC). This includes official scorer, timer, shot clock operator, scoreboard operator, public address announcer, statistics crew and practice coordinator.

GAME OFFICIALS

The ACC will select and assign officials to work all games in Bad Boy Mowers Women's Battle 4 Atlantis. Debbie Williamson will serve as the Tournament's on-site administrator and will make each game's officiating assignments in accordance with NCAA Tournament guidelines. Per NCAA guidelines, officiating assignments may be obtained one hour before game time. Each game's officials will be posted in the locker rooms.

GAME TIMES

Games will vary by day based on TV scheduling which will be available at a later date. Each individual team's game schedule will be determined by its performance in the Tournament.

In the event of late-running or overtime games, teams will be provided a minimum of 20 minutes warm-up. A timing sheet will be provided to each team prior to the start of the game. Games will never start before their publicized times.

HOME TEAM DESIGNATION

The team listed on the top slot of each game in the bracket will be the designated Home team and will occupy the Home bench.

HOSPITAL/SPORTS MEDICINE

A Sports Medicine specialist, EMT, and an ambulance will be on-site at the facility. Doctors are on staff at Princess Margaret Hospital and Doctor's Hospital, located within five minutes of the Sports Facility.

LAUNDRY

Uniform and practice gear laundry services will be provided during the event. There is a limit of five complimentary washes for the week. Further details will be communicated by Team Hosts upon arrival to The Bahamas.

LOCKER ROOMS

Teams will be assigned a locker room on game days only. Teams will not have access to locker rooms during practices or shoot-arounds. See Appendix E.

LOST AND FOUND

The lost and found desk is located at the entrance to the Imperial Arena at letter E on the Sports Facility Map located in Appendix E.

MEDICAL INSURANCE

It is the responsibility of each participating institution to provide, at its own expense, medical insurance for all participating players, coaches, administrators and personnel traveling as part of the official travel party.

NATIONAL ANTHEM

The national anthems of The United States and The Bahamas will be performed prior to the first game of each tournament day. Teams should remain on the court for both anthems.

NON-PARTICIPATING SEATING

When teams are not participating, they will be seated in a designated area of the Arena. Non-participating bands/cheerleaders must purchase tickets to the game when their team is not playing.

PRACTICE

Each team will be assigned specific on-site practices based on the Tournament game schedule. On Friday, November 19, 2021, each team will be assigned one 55-minute practice in the Imperial Arena. Immediately following this, an additional 55-minute practice period will be assigned in the Practice Facility. All game day shoot-arounds will be 55 minutes in duration and take place in the Practice Facility.

Teams will not have access to locker rooms during practices. However, teams will have access to a practice staging area 30 minutes prior to their scheduled practice time. Please refer to letter A on the Sports Facility Map for the Imperial Arena staging area and letter B for the Practice Facility staging area. See Appendix E.

All practices will be closed. Admission will be granted to the official 30-person travel party only. Teams may request access for additional individuals by submitting names to your Team Host at least twenty-four (24) hours prior to the first practice. See Appendix C for the Additional Practice Guests form.

The Practice Facility will only be available for the scheduled practice times found on Appendix C.

PRACTICE BALLS

Nike Elite basketballs are the official basketball of Bad Boy Mowers Women's Battle 4 Atlantis. Practice balls will be available in the Practice Facility for use by all teams.

PRE-TOURNAMENT MEETING

A minimum of one member from each school's basketball staff is required to attend the Pre-Tournament Meeting on Friday, November 19, 2021 in Kronos at 10 a.m. in the Kronos Boardroom in the Sports Facility.

PLAYER INTRODUCTIONS

The starting line-up of the designated Away team will be introduced first, followed by the starting line-up of the designated Home team.

SECURITY

Each team will be assigned security coverage from the Resort.

SPORTS FACILITY See Appendix E.

TEAM ENTRANCE

For practices, teams should enter the Player Zone through the practice staging areas, designated by letters A and B on the Sports Facility Map in Appendix E.

TEAM HOST

Your Team Host has been assigned and is scheduled to meet your team upon arrival. Team Hosts are assigned to offer any assistance to your team and staff while you are at Atlantis as our guests. Team Hosts will provide you with a tournament package upon arrival. This package will include tournament and practice schedules, a detailed itinerary for the week and all relevant credentials. We trust the Team Host experience is a beneficial one. You will be introduced to your Team Host prior to arrival.

TEAM MEALS

The Tournament will supply the participating teams with three meals on each day of the Tournament, one of these meals will be the pre-game meal. Breakfast will be served in a common area for all teams, with designated tables between 7:30 a.m. and 10:30 a.m. each game day.

Lunch and dinner will be served in private meal rooms in the Player Zone. Pre-game meals will be served in the team meeting room so that you are able to watch film. For teams playing in the first game each day, breakfast will be replaced by your pre-game meal in your designated meeting room.

Changes or additions to the tournament menus will be accommodated and any additional charges will be at the expense of the team.

TEAM MEETING ROOMS

The Tournament will supply to each participating school a meeting room that will be available at scheduled times based on the game schedule. These rooms will be equipped with a DVD player, TV screen, chairs, tables and a whiteboard. Any additional equipment required will incur a cost to the team and can be coordinated through your designated Tournament Planning Partner.

Pre-game meals will be served in the meeting rooms.

TEAM ON-SITE TRANSPORTATION

Teams are within walking distance of the Arena and Sports Facility from each hotel at Atlantis. No on-site transportation is necessary. Game day transportation can be arranged at an additional cost for the official team by motor coach from the front door of The Royal. Due to close proximity, teams staying in The Coral will be able to walk to the Arena.

TEAM SCHEDULE

Team meals and meeting rooms will be allocated based on the game and practice times as dictated by the tournament schedule. Teams will have the ability to make changes to the meal and meeting room times based on the availability of the rooms, and such requests should be made through the Team Host.

TIME-OUT POLICY

Standard time-out policies will be followed for all Tournament games.

TOURNAMENT DAYS

November 20-22, 2021

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

The Tournament is a non-elimination tournament with each team playing one game per day for three days. There will be four games per day. The game schedule will be communicated at a later date. All games will be televised on ESPN networks. All games are Eastern Standard Time (EST).

TOWELS, ICE AND WATER

Towels, ice, water and isotonic product will be provided at all practices and games.

TRAINING FACILITIES

Each team is required to travel with its own trainer and supplies (including tape, wraps, etc.). A taping table, hydroculator, biohazard kit, ice and ice bags, and AED equipment will be provided in the Practice Facility and inside each locker room. A stationary bike will also be provided in both the Imperial Arena and the Practice Facility.

UNIFORM DESIGNATION

The designated Home team should wear its light uniform and the Away team should wear its dark uniform.

WELCOME RECEPTION

Atlantis will host a Welcome Reception on Friday, November 19, 2021, at 7 p.m. All teams are expected to attend. Admission to the Welcome Reception is complimentary for the official travel party. Dress code is resort casual.

WORKOUT FACILITIES

There is a fitness center available at the Resort. Access will be included for up to two guests per room, per day.

Our television partners may request up to five (5) minutes to film during your practice in the Imperial Arena on Friday, November 19, 2021. More specific requests will be coordinated through the Tournament's media representatives and provided upon your arrival.

PRE-GAME INTERVIEWS

Thirty-minute interviews will be conducted on Friday, November 19, 2021.

POST GAME INTERVIEWS

All head coaches and student-athletes must be available for a post-game interview following their participation in all Tournament games. Press conferences with the competing coaches and players will be held in the Press Conference room, located in the Media Center, following each game. After a 10-minute cooling off period, the head coach and at least two players from the winning team are to report to the interview area for a session limited to 10 minutes. The head coach and at least two players from the losing team are to report to the interview area immediately after the winning team completes its interview session. The only exception is the Championship Game where the losing team will appear first. A media representative will notify each team of specific requests.

Schools are required at a minimum to send two players and the head coach for interviews and radio.

MEDIA ACCOMMODATIONS

A limited number of rooms at the resort will be available at a special discounted rate for media. All media requests for these rooms should be made through Katie.Longley@AtlantisParadise.com.

MEDIA CREDENTIALS

Spouses or children will not be allowed in these areas. RADIO

All necessary radio equipment will be provided on-site for stations wishing to broadcast courtside. There should be no equipment transported to The Bahamas. The Tournament will provide on-site engineers, who will work with each station during their respective games, including all pre and post-game shows. Institutions' stations will be permitted to broadcast during their teams' games only. Each team's radio personnel will have assigned seating on media row, opposite the team benches, for their broadcast.
