EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID 19 PANDEMIC) (MANAGEMENT AND RECOVERY)(NORTH ANDROS, CENTRAL ANDROS AND CAT ISLAND LOCKDOWN) (AMENDMENT)(NO. 4) ORDER, 2021

In exercise of the powers conferred by the Emergency Powers (Covid 19 Pandemic)(Management and Recovery) Regulations, 2021, I HEREBY make the following Order —

1. Citation.

This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Covid 19 Pandemic) (Management and Recovery) (North Andros, Central Andros and Cat Island Lockdown) (Amendment) (No. 4) Order; 2021.

2. Amendment of order 6 of the principal Order.

Parargraph (2)(d) of order 6 of the principal Order is amended by the deletion of the words "5:00 am and 9:00 am" and the substitution of the words "9:00 am and 3:00 pm".

3. Amendment of order 7 of the principal Order.

Paragraph (3) of Order 7 is amended in subparagraph (d), by the insertion immediately after the "of" of the words "a school examination or".

4. Amendment of order 9 of the principal Order.

Parargraph (2)(d) of order 9 of the principal Order is amended by the deletion of the words "5:00 am and 9:00 am" and the substitution of the words "9:00 am and 3:00 pm".

5. Amendment of order 10 of the principal Order.

Paragraph (3) of order 10 of the principal Order is amended—

(a) in subparagraph (d), —

- (i) by the insertion immediately after the "of" of the words "a school examination or"; and
- (ii) by the deletion of the full stop and the substitution of a semi colon; and
- (b) by the insertion immediately after subparagraph (d) of the following new subparagraph—
 - "(e) a person shall be permitted to harvest crabs—
 - (i) between the hours of 8:00 pm and 5:00 am; or
 - (ii) outside the hours referred to in subparagraph (e)(i), on the approval of the Royal Bahamas Police Officer in Charge for the settlement of Cat Island where the person lives."
