## EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID 19 PANDEMIC)(RISK MANAGEMENT) REGULATIONS, 2020

# EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID 19 PANDEMIC)(RISK MANAGEMENT)(NO.4)(AMENDMENT)(NO.10) ORDER, 2021

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by the Emergency Powers (Covid 19 Pandemic)(Risk Management) Regulations, 2020, I HEREBY make the following Order—

#### 1. Citation and commencement.

- (1) This Order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Covid 19 Pandemic) (Risk Management)(No.4)(Amendment)(No.10) Order, 2021.
- (2) This Order shall come into force on Thursday the 1st day of April, 2021.

#### 2. Amendment of order 16 of the principal Order.

Order 16 of the principal Order is amended by the deletion of paragraph (3) and the substitution of the following —

- "(3) Notwithstanding paragraph (2)
  - (a) a person ten years old or younger;
  - (b) the pilot or crew of a commercial air operator who are required to overnight not more than one night in The Bahamas;
  - (c) a person travelling from any island except Abaco, Eleuthera, Grand Bahama, Harbour Island or New Providence, to any other island;
  - (d) a person travelling between Abaco Island and one of its surrounding cays;
  - (e) a person travelling between Harbour Island and Eleuthera and its surrounding cays,

shall not be required to undergo a RTPCR COVID 19 molecular diagnostic test in order to obtain a travel health visa.".

#### 3. Amendment of order 18 of the principal Order.

Order 18 of the principal Order is amended by the deletion of paragraph (1) and the substitution of the following —

- "(1) Any person
  - who enters The Bahamas; or (a)
  - travels inter-island from Abaco, Eleuthera, Grand Bahama, (b) Harbour Island or New Providence,

shall on the fifth day after his arrival, be required to undergo a COVID 19 rapid antigen test and submit the results to the Ministry of Health online via the health travel website.".
