(AMENDMENT) (NO. 2) ORDER, 2020**

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by the Emergency Powers (Covid 19 Pandemic) Regulations, 2020, I HEREBY make the following Order —

**1. Citation and commencement.**

This Order, which amends the Emergency Powers (Covid 19 Pandemic) Order, 2020 (*S.I. No. 102 of 2020*), may be cited as the Emergency Powers (Covid 19 Pandemic) (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 2020.

**2. Revocation and replacement of order 10 of the principal Order.**

Order 10 of the Emergency Powers (Covid 19 Pandemic) Order, 2020 is revoked and replaced as follows —

**“10. Restaurants and food vendors.**

- (1) A restaurant may, in accordance with this order, may operate between the hours of 5:00 am and 9:00 pm daily.
- (2) A restaurant may resume indoor dining provided that —
  - (a) the maximum seating of a restaurant shall be fifty percent of the maximum occupancy of that restaurant with a minimum of thirty square feet per person;
  - (b) seating shall be arranged in accordance with physical distancing protocols in accordance with order 4;
  - (c) staff shall wear masks in accordance with order 3;
  - (d) patrons shall be required to wear masks upon entry and exit;
  - (d) staff shall sanitise tables, chairs and other implements used by patrons after each use.
- (3) A restaurant that is unable to operate in accordance with paragraph (2) shall only operate utilizing —
  - (a) curbside pickup or delivery in accordance with the protocol set out in Part A of the *Schedule*;
  - (b) drive thru;
  - (c) take away; or
  - (d) outdoor dining.
- (4) Restaurants and food vendors located at Arawak Cay shall only be permitted to operate in accordance with paragraph (3).

- (5) A mobile takeaway restaurant may operate between the hours of 5:00 am and 9:00 pm provided that —
  - (a) staff shall wear masks in accordance with order 4;
  - (b) patrons shall be required to adhere to physical distancing protocols and wear masks in accordance with orders 3 and 4, respectively.
- (6) For the avoidance of doubt, paragraph (5) only applies to a mobile takeaway restaurant —
  - (a) that has a valid business licence issued under the Business Licence Act, 2010 (*No. 25 of 2010*);
  - (b) that meets aesthetic standards as approved by the Ministry of Works;
  - (c) that has been granted written approval by the Commissioner of Police to occupy a location;
  - (d) whose employees have valid food handlers certifications; and
  - (e) that has been certified by the Ministry of Health.”.

**3. Amendment of order 23 of the principal Order.**

Order 23 of the principal Order is amended by the deletion and substitution of paragraph (7) as follows —

- “(7) A negative test result of a RTPCR COVID 19 molecular diagnostic test shall be valid for a period of ten days from the date on which the test was taken.”.
