Meet the Nominees: Fifth Annual Bahamas Press Club Media Awards

NASSAU, The Bahamas - On February 29, 2020, The Bahamas Press Club will stage its Fifth Annual Media Awards Ceremony themed: "Media in The Digital Age" in Black Tie fashion at the British Colonial Hilton. The awards are being held under the Patronage of The Most Honourable Cornelius A. Smith, ON, Governor-General of The Commonwealth of The Bahamas.

Our initial date was November 16, 2019; but due to financial circumstances in the aftermath of Hurricane Dorian, it was postponed.

A Blue Ribbon Panel of judges spent record-breaking hours reviewing the works submitted by the media in various categories including hard news, sports, features, business, politics, investigative, columns, documentaries and social media. The work must have been printed or aired between November 2018 and August 16, 2019. The deadline for submission was August 17, 2019.

Additionally, we'll be honouring a "Person of the Year," a "Media Trailblazer" and "The Etienne Dupuch Lifetime Achievement Award Recipient".
